

Moving forward we hope to continue this growth and development. Specifically, we feel God has shown us it's time for us to grow. We want to invite you to prayerfully seek God's will and be open to His leading. Do you have a love or deep desire for: Music? Praise and worship? Sharing God's word through music? Serving? Video recording? Then you might consider joining the Praise Team. There are many areas where you can serve. There are obvious out-front places and then those responsibilities behind the scenes. Technical, creative, organizational, vocal, instrumental, visual ect...

You may be asking what is the requirement? Your heart, and your commitment. We won't sugar coat it. The time commitment is Wednesday evenings when we practice 1.5-2 hours and on Sunday morning 9:30 am. - 12:00 or the end of Worship Service.

Pathway Praise Team's purpose is to lead the congregation in praise and worship! Giving our time, talent and service to provide opportunities for people to experience God's love through praise, worship and thanksgiving.

As members of the Pathway Praise Team we ask each person to commit to continuing to learn and improve their personal skills to enhance their service and contributions to the team. Instrument players practice at home, singers work on vocal and presentation, AV techs seek and learn new ways to present and tweak audio and visual aspects. Especially, each member continues to grow spiritually.

The hope is for each position on the team to have one - two people who are able to serve.

We invite you to open your heart and consider if God is nudging you to serve with us.

That's our hope each week as we lead worship from the front stage to the back of the house with sound and visual. We want people to see God not us. We want to get out of the way and let people feel God's presence and Love.
