As many of us now know, thanks to Cathi Neal's efforts, October is Domestic Violence Awareness Month. I thought this would be a good place to provide a little information about domestic violence and a couple resources that provide additional information and places to find help for people who are suffering domestic abuse. According to a 2015 study by the Arizona Coalition to End Sexual and Domestic Violence, over 10 million people in the U.S. experience domestic violence each year. The same study reports that about 1 in 4 women and 1 in 10 men will experience domestic violence in their lifetimes. On a typical day, domestic violence hotlines in the U.S. receive about 19,000 calls.


The National Coalition Against Domestic Violence (NCADV) defines domestic violence as "the willful intimidation, physical assault, battery, sexual assault, and/or other abusive behavior as part of a systematic pattern of power and control perpetrated by one intimate partner against another. It includes physical violence, sexual violence, threats, economic, and emotional/psychological abuse." Abusers come from all groups in society, all cultures, all religions, all economic levels and all backgrounds.

There are many red flags and warning signs of an abuser, a few of them, but not near all, include the following: extreme jealousy, possessiveness, a bad temper, verbal abuse, extremely controlling behavior, blaming the victim for anything bad that happens, abuse of other family members, children, or pets, public embarrassment or humiliation of the victim, etc.

We hope and pray that neither you nor anyone you know is suffering from abuse. However, if someone is, please get them help, or at least provide them with information about places they can get help. 
Christian Symbol
